Follow the instructions on the screen. Check either Yes or No and click the "Submit" button. Your selection will be displayed. You must click the "Confirm" button to register your vote. If you disconnect from the Internet before confirming your choice, your vote will not be registered. You will need to login again to cast your vote. Voting ends at 5:00 p.m. CT, October 31, 2009.

To vote by touch-tone telephone, call 1-800-274-4205

Follow the automated instructions. The Amendment selection you have chosen will be repeated for your confirmation before the vote is registered. If you hang up before confirmation, your vote will not be registered. You will need to call in again to cast your vote. Voting ends at 5:00 p.m. CT, October 31, 2009.

To vote by mail-in ballot

You may vote for ONE choice only. Mark your selection by completely filling in the box with black ink or pencil located next to your choice on the ballot below. Detach the mail-in ballot along the dotted line and mail it in the enclosed prepaid envelope. Mail-in ballot must be postmarked by October 31, 2009.
